Annual General Meeting

3 March 2014

Welcome to our twelfth Annual General Meeting, especially to those members who have joined us during the past year.

Sponsorships

Sponsorships, usually by corporations, continue to be an essential source of income to support our funding objectives. Currently, we have eight Platinum, five Gold, three Silver and three Bronze sponsors and one at Percentage-of-Sales level.

From 16 November 2013, all paid-up sponsors with contributions for the year to date have had the option of taking a full discount of Corporate membership fees for the duration of their sponsorship.

A huge "Thank You" is due to all of our sponsors whose contributions accounted for about 78 per cent of income, and a special thanks to our longer-term sponsors.

About 20 per cent of income came from membership subscriptions.
