President's Report for 2014-5 Annual General Meeting 3 March 2015

Welcome to our thirteenth Annual General Meeting, especially to those members who have joined us during the past year.

Sponsorships

Sponsorships, usually by corporations, continue to be an essential source of income to support our funding objectives. Currently, we have eight Platinum, two Gold, two Silver and five Bronze sponsors.

All paid-up sponsors with contributions for the year to date have had the option of taking a full discount of Corporate membership fees for the duration of their sponsorship.

A huge "Thank You" is due to all of our sponsors whose contributions accounted for about 84 per cent of income, and a special thanks to our longer-term sponsors.

Memberships

About 15 per cent of income came from membership subscriptions. Firebird Documentation funding campaign

The campaign to raise funds to pay for translating the complete Firebird Language Reference manual from Russian to English has been a success, with US\$5025 and EUR 2400 in the kitty. Now as reported at the last committee meeting, "Most native speakers in firebird-doc said that the test translation from Russian to English is awful, and suggested to find foreigners with SQL and Russian knowledge for such translation."

At the moment we are seeking a good translator person and a proofreader-editor for the project.

Grants

The Foundation currently makes 10 ongoing grants, totalling approximately \$14,600 US dollars per month.
